Premium en-suite room	Self-catered	Bright modern rooms include a 4ft-wide bed and en-suite shower room. Each flat of eight or ten bedrooms shares a spacious, modern kitchen/dining area	£161.70
En-suite room	Self-catered	Rooms are comfortable and well-equipped with an en-suite shower room. Each flat of between six and ten rooms share a kitchen/diner	£140.70
Room with shared bathroom	Self-catered	Traditional corridor style halls with washbasins in the rooms. Shared bathroom and kitchens facilities	From £101.01 to £112.00

HOW TO APPLY

- 1 You can apply for accommodation via the personal applicant portal www.reading.ac.uk/applicantportal after you have accepted the official offer of a place on the Study Abroad Programme
- 2 Application deadlines:
 - **1 August** if you are starting your course in September
 - **1 December** if you are starting your course in January
- 3 If you are registering for the programme for the full academic year (September – June) you will usually be made an offer of accommodation within **10 working days** of application
- 4 If you are coming for less than a full academic year you will be notified from mid-August onwards (September start) or December (January start)
- 5 At the time of accepting an accommodation offer you will be asked to pay a deposit of £250

Accommodation contract dates

Study block 1 16/17/18 September 2016 (dependent on the hall you are moving into) to 31 December 2016

Study block 2 1 January to 23/24/25 June 2017 (dependent on the hall you are moving into).
