## PROGRAM STRUCTURE

**18** OR **22** MONTH PROGRAM OPTIONS\*

### Course based option - 18 months

Complete the program in 18 months by concentrating on classroom studies.

### Research paper option - 22 months

After concluding the 18-month option of the program, students can complete the research paper in an additional four months.
