Exchange student place	The number of exchange places is agreed in the student exchange agreement on a reciprocal basis, but it is open to discussion.
Courses available for exchange students	<p>(1) Chinese Learning Program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -offered by School of International Culture and Exchange -taught in English or Chinese; depends on Chinese competence -content: from basic to advance level, including speaking, listening, writing, reading, cultural and historical related courses <p>(2) Regular Courses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -please find in Schools -taught in Chinese: for Chinese competent students (HSK-4 and above) -courses: regular courses related to the applicants' major in home university <p>(3) Arranged Tutoring</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -offered by Schools -for English speaking only applicants -we will try to arrange a tutor for the applicant to do assigned reading, course project, laboratory operating, etc. But there is no guarantee of credit transfer. <p>*Note: the syllabus is only available in Chinese for most study programs and is upon request in early July (for Fall semester) and early January (for Spring semester).</p>
Credit system	For the experimental courses in Lanzhou University, one credit equals to 36 credit hours. For courses of other kinds, one credit corresponds to 18 credit hours. One credit hour equals to 60 minutes of class instruction. E.g. a three credit course normally consists of three lecture hours per week in one semester, since one semester consists of 18 weeks' instruction and two weeks' exam. Grading system .
Course load & Credits	1 credit of Lanzhou University indicates 25-30 hour workload, including 18 credit hours and 7-12 hours of individual study. 15 credits per semester

Accommodation	<p>Lanzhou University provides guaranteed on-campus accommodation for exchange students from our partner university.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pre-assigned International Students' Apartment (double room, 30 RMB/day, 4500RMB/semester)
Accommodation fees	<p>Self-paid, unless specifically waived according to the agreement or upon evaluation of the exchange program. Please contact the Office to confirm. For the accommodation fee waived exchange students, there will be a 600RMB deposit upon accommodation registration.</p>
Health insurance requirements	<p>Exchange students must obtain health insurance for the entire length of their exchange. They must purchase the relevant insurance upon arrival at Lanzhou University (about 400RMB/semester).</p>
Tuition fees	<p>Waived for exchange students from partner universities.</p>
Visa information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students with X1 (000 day) visa should apply for residence permit within 30 days after arrival. Supporting documents are needed. ● Students with X2 (120/150/180 days) visa may or may not need to apply for residence permit within 30 days after arrival, which depends on their exchange period. For one semester (5 months) exchange students, we suggest them to apply for X2 (150/180 days) visa. <p>It would cost exchange students approx. 400 RMB to apply for residence permit. The volunteers will assist them to obtain the required supporting documents.</p>
Volunteers-Buddy program	<p>The International Office will arrange a Chinese student volunteer with adequate language proficiency to provide necessary assistance to each international exchange student. Every incoming international exchange student should keep in close touch with the assigned volunteer.</p>
Living expenses	<p>Estimated Costs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Food: about 1000-2000 RMB per month ● Books: about 350 RMB per semester
Arrival pick-up service	<p>Student volunteers (buddies to exchange students) will pick up exchange students from the airport or train station upon request. Exchange students will be responsible for the shuttle bus fee by themselves.</p>



Local transportation	<p>Lanzhou University is located in downtown area.</p> <p>10 minutes drive to the train station</p> <p>1 hour drive to the airport.</p>
Campus facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Wired Internet Service will be provided in the international students' apartment upon request and it is self-paid.● Free Wi-Fi is provided in the library, teaching buildings and the central office building (Guiqin Bldg.).● Dining halls and Muslim canteen are located on the campus.
